



Refresh Project Update

(You will recall that "Refresh" is the name we have given to the challenging project of bringing our 30-year-old church hall into the 21st century.)

The interest people have shown in our plans to refresh the Parish Centre has been very encouraging and we are grateful for all of the many good ideas and suggestions that we have received. The project will improve the carbon footprint and make the Centre a great place to be used by the Grandpont community and the church for another 30 years.

We held an open meeting in May where we talked about the conclusions from the technical work that has been done, and our architect explained the various Refresh opportunities that could be open to us. The good news we have discovered is that the building, although 30 years old, is already fairly well insulated. This gives us confidence that we should be able to heat it using green electricity, rather than continuing with a replacement for our old and ailing gas boiler.

So now we are digesting the feedback we have received, and over the summer we will be deciding what changes and improvements to include. All comments and ideas are still very welcome.
