An observation from one of your deliverers!

I wasn't aware of the complexities of letter boxes until I began delivering St Matthnews along a Victorian street in the parish. I had thought that all post boxes were like mine, about eight inches long in the middle of the door and sufficiently wide to take a newspaper or even a slim paperback. There were a few like that in the street where I delivered but not many. Some letter boxes were so tiny that St Matthnews had to be folded very small, others were so low down that they required me to kneel.
